Do you know how to check your blood pressure


Undiagnosed high blood pressure (hypertension) could have serious consequences but did you know you can take your own blood pressure reading? And it's easy! As long as you have not artificially raised your blood pressure in the last half an hour by:

- Exercisir
- Smokin
- · Having tea, coffee or other caffeinated drinks

Then take a seat, relax for five minutes and follow the instructions below.

Remember, record the exact numbers from the machine and do not

round up or down.



Taking a number of readings throughout the week, around the same time each day, will help you to know your numbers better. If you are concerned about your blood pressure readings you can visit your local pharmacy, contact your GP surgery or call the British Heart Foundation Helpline on 0300 330 3311. 
